***Activities & Relaxation:**

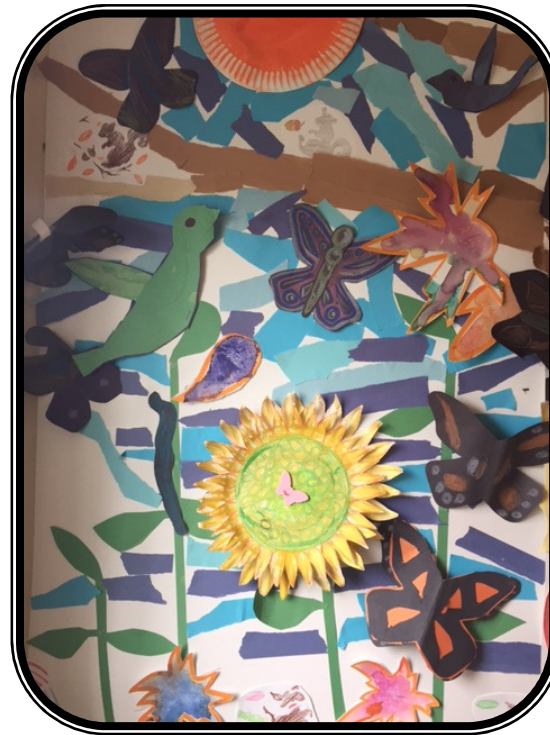
Creativity, gym, arts and crafts, books, conversation, building toys, Legos, LOTS of outdoor play, music, quiet areas.

Daily Schedule:
Before School Club

*6:45am arrivals begin- quiet table games, reading time, breakfast from home.

*7:30am arrivals continue- More active break out time in the gym, with manipulatives, games and sport equipment, then clean up and gather for dismissal to morning recess or school breakfast.

*8:20am dismissal to school

2-Hours delays: The Before School Club will open @ 8:45.

After School Club

*3:15 Elementary school student dismissed

*3:15 -5:00 Opportunity to complete homework with support, arts/crafts, gym time, outdoors, outdoor local walking, clean-up and prepare for pick-up.

*5:00 pm CLOSED

Additional things your child should have or be prepared for:

Children should be packed with additional health snacks for both morning & afternoon programs, a water bottle is a great idea too!

We are outside **A LOT!** Weather appropriate clothes are a must and extra clothes are a good idea too!

Weather Related Release: If school is dismissed **before** 1:00pm the **After School Club** is closed, if early release is issued **after** 1:00pm, the program will start at release time and run as scheduled even if ConVal sponsored after activities are cancelled. *We are closed when school is cancelled or closed.*



Enrollment Opportunities & Fees

Registration Fee:

There is an annual registration fee due of \$30. One registration fee per family. Fee is applied to administrative fees and supplies.

Enrollment Choices:

Monthly Enrollment:

Monthly participants receive the best rate, and have a reserved spot on all ConVal school days Monday-Friday. Monthly payments are due at the start of each month and are a set rate divided by the 10 months of school.

Daily Enrollment:

*Daily participants are those registered for a pre-planned days of the week. Payments for Daily services are due on the day of service or on a weekly basis. Daily enrollment means you spot is reserved for your child and you are billed month for those days.

“Once in Awhile” Enrollment:

This service is essentially a drop in service for parents who need unexpected care for their child(ren). Payment is due the day of service, Also this enrollment is based on space permitting. A 24 hour request is need before attending, if possible.
